The Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice, is charged with the duty of investigating violations of the laws of the United States and collecting evidence in cases in which the United States is or may be a party in interest.

The Division does not have investigative jurisdiction over violations of Counterfeiting, Narcotic, Customs, Immigration, or Postal Laws.

However, the Division of Investigation will immediately institute investigations of alleged violations of Federal Laws other than those listed above.

The following list indicates some of the major violations over which the Division has investigative jurisdiction:-

National Motor Vehicle Theft Act

Interstate transportation of stolen property valued at \$5,000 or more National Bankruptcy Act

Interstate flight to avoid prosecution or testifying in certain cases White Slave Traffic Act

Impersonation of Government Officials

Larceny of Goods in Interstate Commerce

Killing or Assaulting Federal Officer

Cases involving transportation in interstate or foreign commerce of any persons who have been kidnapped

Extortion cases in which interstate commerce or interstate communication is an element

Theft, Embezzlement or Illegal Possession of Government Property Antitrust Laws

Robbery of National Banks and Member Banks of Federal Reserve System National Bank and Federal Reserve Act Violations, such as embezzlement, abstraction or misapplication of funds

Crimes on any kind of Government reservation, including Indian Reservations or in any Government building or other Government property Neutrality violations, including the shipment of arms to friendly nations Frauds against the Government

Crimes in connection with Federal Penal and Correctional Institutions Perjury, embezzlement, or bribery in connection with Federal Statutes or officials

Crimes on the high seas

Federal Anti-Racketeering Statute

The location of persons who are fugitives from justice by reason of violations of the Federal Laws over which the Division has jurisdiction, of escaped Federal prisoners, and parole and probation violators.

It will be appreciated if information in the possession of law-enforcement officials concerning the above listed violations is promptly forwarded to the Special Agent in Charge of the nearest field office of the Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice. If the information indicates that immediate action is necessary, telegrams marked "Government Rate Collect" or telephone calls will be accepted. The address of each of the Field Offices of this Division appears on the inside back cover of this bulletin.

I feel certain that all law enforcement officials will be interested in the Federal crime bills summarized below which were passed by the last session of Congress:

RECENT FEDERAL CRIME BILLS

H. R.-9370 - THE FEDERAL REWARD BILL

This Act authorizes the Attorney General to designate any criminal a public enemy and to offer up to \$25,000 reward for the capture of such public enemy, or for information leading to his capture. If any such designated public enemy is killed resisting lawful arrest, the reward may be paid to any person or persons whom the Attorney General shall adjudge to be entitled thereto.

S.-2080 - TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR KILLING OR ASSAULTING FEDERAL OFFICERS

This Act applies Sections 273 and 274 of the Criminal Code to the killing of a Special Agent of the Division of Investigation and other Federal officers while engaged in the performance of official duties or on account thereof. It also provides that whoever shall forcibly resist, oppose, impede, intimidate or interfere with any Special Agent of the Division and other Federal officers while engaged in the performance of official duties, or assault such officer on account of the performance of official duties, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$5,000 or to not more than 2 years imprisonment or both. If such individual uses a deadly or dangerous weapon, the maximum penalty is increased to \$10,000 fine or 10 years imprisonment, or both.

S.-2249 - EXTORTION BY MEANS OF TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, RADIO, CRAL MESSAGE OR OTHERWISE

This Act makes it a Federal crime to transmit in interstate commerce by any means whatsoever, with intent to extort, any threat (1) to injure the person or property of any person, or the reputation of a deceased person, (2) to kidnap any person, (3) to accuse any person of a crime, or (4) containing any demand or request for a ransom or reward for the release of any kidnaped person. The maximum penalty is \$5,000 fine or 20 years imprisonment or both.

S.-2252 - AMENDING THE FEDERAL KIDNAPING ACT OF JUNE 22, 1932

This Amending Act permits imposition of the death penalty where recommended by the trial jury. The Amending Act excepts the case of a minor taken by his parent, and has the added provision that the death penalty shall not be imposed if prior to its imposition the

kidnaped person has been released unharmed. The Amending Act makes illegal the interstate or foreign transportation of any person unlawfully seized, confined, inveigled, decoyed, kidnaped, abducted or carried away by any means whatsoever and held for ransom or reward or otherwise, and provides further that the failure to release such person within seven days after his seizure shall create a presumption that he has been transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

S.-2253 - FLEEING FROM ONE STATE TO ANOTHER TO AVOID PROSECUTION OR GIVING TESTIMONY IN CERTAIN CASES

This Act makes it a Federal crime to (1) move or travel in interstate or foreign commerce to avoid prosecution for murder, burglary, robbery, mayhem, rape, assault with a dangerous weapon, extortion with threats of violence, or the attempt to commit any of these crimes, or (2) to avoid giving testimony in any criminal proceedings in which a felony is charged. Prosecution lies in the Federal Judicial District in which the original crime is alleged to have been committed, and the maximum penalty is \$5,000 fine or 5 years imprisonment or both.

S.-2845 - THE NATIONAL STOLEN PROPERTY ACT

This Act in effect simply extends the provisions of the National Motor Vehicle Theft Act to the transportation in interstate or foreign commerce of stolen goods, wares, merchandise, securities or money of the value of \$5,000 or over. The maximum penalty is \$10,000 fine or 10 years imprisonment or both.

S.-2841 - ROBBERY OF BANKS ORGANIZED OR OPERATING UNDER LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES OR OF ANY MEMBER OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE SYSTEM

This Act in effect makes it a Federal crime to rob or attempt to rob by force, violence, or putting in fear, any bank organized or operating under the laws of the United States, or any member of the Federal Reserve System. The maximum penalty is \$5,000 fine or 20 years imprisonment or both. If the commission of the crime or its attempted commission results in the assault of any person or puts the life of any person in jeopardy through the use of a dangerous weapon or device, a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$10,000 may be imposed or imprisonment for not less that 5 nor more than 25 years, or both. If in committing any of the offenses defined in the Act in avoiding, or attempting to avoid apprehension therefor or in freeing or attempting to free himself from arrest or confinement for such offenses, any individual kills any person or forces any person to accompany him without the person's consent, the penalty shall be imprisonment for not less than 10 years or death if the verdict of the jury so directs.

S.-2575 - CRIMES IN CONNECTION WITH FEDERAL PENAL AND CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS

This Act makes it a Federal crime for any person including

officers and employees of Federal penal or correctional institutions to instigate, connive at, wilfully attempt to cause, assist in, or to conspire to cause any mutiny, riot or escape at a Federal penal or correctional institution. The conveyance into or within such institution or assisting in such conveyance of any tool, device, firearm, weapon, explosive, lethal and poisonous gas or any other substance or thing designed to aid in escape or to disable any officer, agent, employee or inmate is also made a crime. The maximum punishment for any of the above crimes is 10 years imprisonment.

H.R.-9741 - THE NATIONAL FIREARMS ACT

This Act provides for the taxation of manufacturers, importers, and dealers in certain firearms and machine guns, and makes provision for the taxation and registration of all sales, transfers or other disposition of certain firearms in interstate transportation. Shotguns and rifles with barrels less than 18 inches in length, machine guns, sub-machine guns and silencers are covered by the Act.

H.R.-9476 - POWER OF ARREST FOR SPECIAL AGENTS OF THE DIVISION, AND THE RIGHT TO CARRY FIREARMS

This Act gives Special Agents of the Division of Investigation authority to serve warrants and subpenas issued under the authority of the United States and to make arrests for felonies cognizable under the Federal law where there is a likelihood of escape before a warrant can be procured. In the latter case the arrested person must be taken before a committing officer immediately. The Act also specifically authorizes Division Agents to carry firearms.

S.-2248 - FEDERAL ANTI-RACKETEERING STATUTE

The avowed purpose of this Act is to protect interstate trade and commerce against interference by violence, threats, coercion or intimidation. Any interference by any of the above means is made a felony punishable by imprisonment not to exceed 10 years, or by a fine not to exceed \$10,000. or both.

BUSTER BROWN

INTERESTING IDENTIFICATION

UNKNOWN DECEASED PERSON IDENTIFIED THROUGH FINGERPRINTS

On June 13, 1934 the fingerprints of an unknown deceased male negro were received in the Identification Unit of the Division of Investigation from the State's Attorney's office, Cumberland, Maryland. Information appeared on the fingerprint card that this unidentified person had been killed by a freight train on June 12, 1934 at Cumberland, Maryland.

This fingerprint card was classified and searched in the technical files, and it was ascertained that the deceased person was identical with Buster Brown, alias William Brown, who, in December, 1932 had been arrested by the Police Department at Scranton, Pennsylvania, and had been sentenced on a charge of larceny to a term of one year in the Lackawanna County Jail. At the time of this sentence his address was reported as 1531 East Fifteenth Street, Erie, Pennsylvania. On the same day that the fingerprint card was received, the State's Attorney's office at Cumberland, Maryland was notified by wire of the identification.

The fingerprint files reflected an extensive criminal record on this individual, which included arrests by the police departments of Kearny, New Jersey, Lancaster, Pittsburgh and Scranton, Pennsylvania and Akron, Ohio; and incarcerations in the Ohio State Penitentiary, Columbus, Ohio, the Hudson County Jail at Jersey City, New Jersey and the Essex County Penitentiary at Caldwell, New Jersey.

It is observed that law-enforcement agencies with increasing frequency are availing themselves of the services of the Identification Unit for the purpose of determining the identity of unknown deceased persons. The above case is typical of the numerous identifications that are effected in this field of activity.

JUDY JORDAN

ESCAPED FLORIDA LIFE CONVICT APPREHENDED AT WINNIPEG IDENTIFIED THROUGH FINGERPRINTS

In June, 1934, an identification was effected in the fingerprint files of the Division of Investigation which illustrates the practical value of the fingerprint method in the location of fugitives using aliases, who are taken into custody by peace officers at points far distant from the scenes of crimes, or their escape while serving terms therefor.

On June 29, 1934, a fingerprint card was received at the Division by air mail from the Police Department, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, which indicated that one John Ercheeson had been arrested on June 26, 1934 and charged with the crime of bank robbery. The fingerprint card was searched immediately through the fingerprint files which resulted in the identification of the fingerprints of John Ercheeson with those of one Judy Jordan whose file reflected that he had escaped from the State Road Camp No. 1, near Ponce De Leon, Florida, on January 13, 1933. Jordan had been convicted of murder in the first degree with a recommendation for mercy by the Circuit Court of Volusia County, Florida, and had been sentenced on June 3, 1930 to serve a sentence for his natural life.

The Florida and Winnipeg authorities were immediately notified by telegraph of the identification. Information was subsequently received from Winnipeg advising that Jordan, alias Ercheeson, was being held for the Florida Authorities.

This is one of many such fugitive identifications effected in the Identification Unit of the Division of Investigation in the course of the routine classification and the search of approximately 2,200 fingerprint cards received each day.

OFFENSES KNOWN TO THE POLICE January to June, 1934

There is presented in the following compilation, the number of offenses reported for the first six months of 1934 by the police departments in 88 cities with more than 100,000 inhabitants. The figures are also presented in the form of daily averages. In comparing the amount of crime reported in the several months, it is preferable to employ the daily averages, since the number of days in each of the months is not the same.

The compilation discloses that during the second quarter of 1934 the number of offenses of murder and nonnegligent manslaughter exceeded the number reported during the first three months of the year. The same is true with reference to cases of aggravated assault. However, cases of robbery, burglary, and larceny decreased during the second quarter.

THE EXAMINATION OF ANONYMOUS LETTERS--IMPORTANCE OF SCIENTIFIC ANALYSIS AS AID TO IDENTIFICATION

By Albert S. Osborn

Several times a year in these criminal days the finding of the writer of an anonymous letter demanding a ransom is a task in which a whole nation may be interested and thousands of persons engaged. The writer of the Lindbergh kidnaping letters has not been found, but numerous of these actors, in what has become a well-established new crime, are either dead or behind prison bars for life. This present kidnaping mania in the American criminal world, with its many advance threats and written demands for ransom money, has perhaps stimulated other anonymous letter writers and brought the present flood of these peculiar missives. Many mail-bags contain them. They range from harmless mental explosions up to deliberate conspiracies that may lead to murder.

The examination of important communications of this kind is often superficial and unscientific. The most important phase of such an examination is often omitted entirely. This phase is a careful study and analysis of every word, statement and idea in the anonymous letter with a view of determining, first, its exact purpose and, second, in order to make an accurate estimate of the educational, cultural and general qualifications of the writer. After this first important study it may not be necessary to make any handwriting or typewriting comparisons. The two detailed analyses printed herewith will be useful in an examination of this kind to one who is qualified to apply them. In many instances a particular suspected writer can be dismissed at once after such an analysis is carefully made.

Not only the primary but the secondary and partly hidden purpose of a letter may be disclosed by a careful analysis, and this information may be very important in an investigation. Threatening letters are sometimes written simply to frighten or annoy or to make one disagreeable statement.

Disguises in these letters are of course to be expected. They are of varied character. It should be known that hand-printing or typewriting do not always hide the criminal performer. It is impossible in a letter, as in a conversation, for one successfully to assume a cultural or educational status superior to his own qualifications, and a part of disguise often is an assumed illiteracy, but actual illiteracy can usually be distinguished from assumed illiteracy. Evidence of education in the use of words, punctuation and construction of sentences may be combined with improbable errors in spelling. This educational question should be given the most careful study, as it may be the key to the problem.

Not all phases of the outlines below are applicable in every case, but some of them, especially those relating to education, will apply in any inquiry. Of course, as suggested, if the examiner himself is not educationally and culturally qualified, he will not be able properly to appraise certain qualities of language and composition. The location of a modifier means nothing to one who is not a student of language, and the typical errors of ignorance are of course unknown to one who is himself ignorant. In some instances the use of a single phrase, or even a single word, in a letter is highly illuminating, and

in other instances the evidence of knowledge of a particular fact may have a direct bearing upon an investigation.

When an anonymous letter is thus analyzed, the number of possible writers in a particular community often is greatly reduced, until there are left only a small group. This eliminating procedure, of course, makes it easier to find the writer of such a letter than incorrectly to assume in advance that it may have been written by any one of a hundred thousand possible writers. There occasionally are ananymous letters, received, like THE LETTERS OF JUNIUS, that in language and composition are of so high a quality that only a few writers, even in a great city, could have written them. A long series of such letters came out of Philadelphia a few years ago in connection with the poisoning of a malpractitioner. One of the letters said, "I remove him as I would a weed from a garden." Anonymous letters are, however, as a rule, of a low order in every way.

It also should be known that the first suspected writer in an anonymous letter inquiry many times is not the actual writer, and hasty accusations are always dangerous. In some instances an investigation begins only after someone has been wrongly accused of having written a vile letter. It is much better to file such a letter for possible future comparison with a second communication that may come, and do nothing about it, than to jump to a conclusion on unreliable evidence that may lead to embarrassment and possibly heavy damages. It is highly important to realize in advance that it is better to suffer in silence rather than make an incorrect accusation.

It may be some satisfaction to distressed recipients of anonymous letters to know that persons in responsible positions, and especially wealthy citizens of many communities, receive many anonymous letters. Some of these missives are the product of untalanced minds, and this, as suggested in the outline of procedure, is a question that should always be thoroughly considered in making an analysis of such a document. Insane writers require no motive. The actual motives for writing anonymous letters are not very numerous and, as a rule, can be brought into perhaps a half dozen different divisions. If it can be determined just what probably led to the writing of a letter, this fact alone, as stated above, may greatly reduce the number of possible writers.

Letters many times, however, grow out of trivial incidents that are entirely forgotten by the recipient of a letter. Fortunately, the average anonymous letter writer is not a skilful performer and often in effect writes a name all over a communication, but this interesting information does not come to the untrained and inexperienced examiner, and no action regarding an anonymous letter should be taken on the casual opinion of a bank clerk or unqualified detective.

It should be better understood that an examination of an anonymous letter is in large part a reasoning process and errors, of course, are to be expected of those who cannot reason. Things seen, that are of vital importance, may mean nothing to the unqualified observer. Errors, in failing to identify the suspected writer or in accusing the wrong person, are being made all the time regarding the identification of anonymous letter writers that could be avoided if the contents of the letter were examined as suggested in the analyses printed herewith. Let the letter, or letters, be typewritten exactly as they appear, line for line, word for word, and letter for letter, and then they should be read by the mind and not merely with the eyes.

For the protection of the innocent, it should also be known that handwritings in the same language are bound to be similar in many ways and if, as is often done, one looks only for similarities, some of them usually can be found in the handwriting of the one first suspected, whether or not that writer wrote the anonymous letter.
