The Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice, is charged with the duty of investigating violations of the laws of the United States and collecting evidence in cases in which the United States is or may be a party in interest.

The Division does not have investigative jurisdiction over violations of Counterfeiting, Narcotic, Customs, Immigration, or Postal Laws.

However, the Division of Investigation will immediately institute investigations of alleged violations of Federal Laws other than those listed above.

The following list indicates some of the major violations over which the Division has investigative jurisdiction:-

National Motor Vehicle Theft Act
National Bankruptcy Act
White Slave Traffic Act
Impersonation of Government Officials
Larceny of Goods in Interstate Commerce
Cases involving transportation in interstate or foreign commerce of
any persons who have been kidnapped
Theft, Embezzlement or Illegal Possession of Government Property
Antitrust Laws

National Bank and Federal Reserve Act Violations, such as embezzlement, abstraction or misapplication of funds

Crimes on any kind of Government reservation, including Indian Reservations or in any Government building or other Government property

Neutrality violations, including the shipment of arms to friendly nations

Frauds against the Government

Perjury, embezzlement, or bribery in connection with Federal Statutes or officials

Crimes on the high seas

The location of persons who are fugitives from justice by reason of violations of the Federal Laws over which the Division has jurisdiction, of escaped Federal prisoners, and parole and probation violators.

It will be appreciated if information in the possession of law-enforcement officials concerning the above listed violations is promptly forwarded to the Special Agent in Charge of the nearest field office of the Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice. If the information indicates that immediate action is necessary, telegrams marked "Government Rate Collect" or telephone calls will be accepted. The address of each of the Field Offices of this Division appears on the inside back cover of this bulletin.

On this occasion, I desire to invite your attention to the crime statistics functions of the Division of Investigation. Pursuant to an Act of Congress approved by the President on June 11, 1930, the Division assumed the compilation of police statistics, which work had been carried on under the auspices of the Committee on Uniform Crime Records of the International Association of Chiefs of Police since January of that year.

The Division is glad to be of service to law enforcement officials by collecting, tabulating, and publishing crime statistics and I have been greatly pleased with the cooperation afforded by law enforcement officials generally in the development of this project. During 1930 one or more monthly crime reports were received from the police departments in 1,127 cities with an aggregate population of 45,929,965. Continuous growth has been evidenced in the reporting area with the result that during 1933 one or more reports were received from the police departments in 1,658 cities representing a total population of 62,357,262. In addition reports were received from a large number of sheriffs, state police units, and officers in the possessions.

Such widespread cooperation in the collection of crime statistics on a national scale indicates that law enforcement officials generally recognize that adequate crime statistics are essential not only to the efficient administration of each local organization but to an intelligent study of the crime problem on a national scale with a view to the formulation of a remedial program.

During 1930 and 1931 data compiled from monthly crime reports were published in the monthly bulletin entitled Uniform Crime Reports and the bulletin contained figures submitted by individual contributors. Due primarily to the need for economy, the bulletin was published quarterly during 1932 and 1933 and was limited to tables of a summary nature. The compilations included made it possible, however, to compare crime rates for cities divided according to size, to determine crime trends from month to month and from year to year, and to compare crime rates for individual states and geographic divisions of the country. In the issue of the bulletin for the first quarter of 1934, there will be included crime rates for individual cities with population in excess of one hundred thousand. This plan has been adopted in accordance with the recommendation of the Committee on Uniform Crime Records of the International Association of Chiefs of Police and it is believed that the publication of such data will add to the interest and value of the bulletin.

Since 1932 the bulletin has included in addition to information compiled from uniform crime reports data pertaining to the age, sex, race and previous criminal history of individuals arrested and fingerprinted, as evidenced by fingerprint cards received in the Identification Unit of the Division of Investigation. Judging by the large number of requests for that type of information, the compilation thereof meets a long felt need and presents much information of significance regarding the personal characteristics and histories of individuals arrested by the police.

In order to make the information available at more frequent intervals, the Division has inaugurated the plan of publishing each month in the Fugitive Bulletin, the daily average number of offenses reported by cities with population in excess of one hundred thousand. This information is being published in order to furnish current data regarding crime trends.

The bulletin Uniform Crime Reports is distributed without cost to contributors of crime statistics and to other individuals interested in the information included therein. Suggestions as to any manner in which the compilation or publication of police statistics may be improved upon are at all times welcomed.

At this time I again wish to express my appreciation of your cooperation in this project and to assure you that the Division will continue to endeavor to render efficient service in connection with the compilation of crime statistics.

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TECHNICAL LABORATORY IN THE DIVISION OF INVESTIGATION

In the latter part of the year 1932 the Division of Investigation, United States Department of Justice, established a Technical Laboratory to perform work of a scientific character, which might prove of assistance in its investigative cases. Previously, it had been customary in instances considered desirable for the Division to have technical experts outside its organization to make scientific analyses. The importance and growth of this phase of the Division's investigative activity and the desirability of having the work under its close supervision led to the conclusion that the establishment of a Technical Laboratory was essential.

The development of the Laboratory has been carefully planned by the Division with the assistance and advice of Dr. Wilmer Souder, a well-known and recognized authority in the field of scientific endeavor. Dr. Souder, who is at present acting in an advisory capacity in the further development of the Laboratory, has been engaged as a scientist by the Bureau of Standards for a period of eighteen years and has devoted the principal portion of his time to handwriting, typewriting and ballistics identification. His advice and experience have rendered invaluable service to the Division in the training of the laboratory personnel and in obtaining equipment which is considered the most desirable and essential for the performance of its work.

Some of the instruments used in the technical work include the comparison microscope, in which the images of two separate bullets are brought within a single eyepiece for comparison; the binocular microscope which uses low magnification for the examination of handwriting, typewriting and other specimens with which it is an advantage to utilize the stereoscopic principle; the research microscope which enables magnification up to 1400 times to be obtained; the ultra-violet lamp for the examination of the fluorescent and phosphorescent appearances of objects and substances through which they may be identified; special cameras for photographing specimens; chemical apparatus for the examination of blood stains, qualitative and quantitative analyses; delicate balances, and similar instruments.

At the present, examinations are made in the Laboratory of documents or letters to determine the identity of the typewriting or the handwriting appearing thereon, the existence of watermarks and any other information which may prove helpful in the investigation of the case. In addition, ballistics is considered an important phase of the scientific work and comparisons are made whenever the occasion demands of bullets and exploded shells. Moulage is another feature which the Laboratory is equipped to undertake. This consists of the making of casts of parts of the human body and these casts are frequently of value in the trial of a case to show the exact location of the wound or for identification purposes.

Micro-analyses of hairs and fibres are likewise considered as an essential and important part of the technical duties, and chemical analyses of stains including blood tests are performed from time to time.

At this time considerable Laboratory research is being conducted. Further there are being obtained complete collections of watermarks, tire tread patterns, bullets, cartridges and powders and typewriting specimens to assist in the performance of the Laboratory examinations as outlined above. These standard specimens will be located in the Laboratory and will be made available to all law enforcement officials desiring to utilize them.

INTERESTING CASES

Scientific examination of materials in the course of an investigation may serve the innocent as well as convict the guilty. A striking example of this is found in a recent extortion case investigated by Special Agents of the Division of Investigation. During 1932 and 1933 a prominent court official of Ripley, Mississippi, received a series of anonymous letters demanding sums of money ranging from \$1,000.00 to \$30,000.00 and threatening death to both himself and his family if the money was not paid. A local individual who had lost considerable money in business ventures and who had at one time been regarded as of unsound mind, was suspected of being the author of these threatening letters. The extortion notes together with specimens of the handwriting of the suspect were forwarded by the Division's Agents to the Laboratory at Washington, D. C. After examination, a report was made, accompanied by illustrated charts, to the effect that this suspect did not write the extortion letters.

While the threats were being made against the life of the victim, a bomb was exploded in his home, and a subsequent letter indicated this explosion had resulted as a part of the extortion plot. During the course of their investigation, the Division's Agents received information that one Mark Cyril Spencer, who lived about thirty miles from Ripley, Mississippi, had been seen with three sticks of dynamite before the explosion, at which time he had made a statement that he was going to put this dynamite under the home of the official. At the instance of the Division's Agents, warrants were issued for Spencer and two others and they were subsequently taken into custody. Spencer denied writing the extortion notes. Samples of his handwriting were forwarded to Washington and experts of the Laboratory reported the writing was identical with that of the extortion notes, in spite of deliberate disguise in the latter.

Enlarged charts substantiating this handwriting identification were prepared for presentation in court. Envelopes found in the home of Spencer after his arrest were identified in the Laboratory as being identical with envelopes used to transmit the extortion notes. An expert of the Division presented this evidence at the trial of Spencer in Memphis, Tennessee, on February 27, 1934, and after presentation of the Government's case, Spencer changed his plea to guilty. Spencer was sentenced to serve 20 years in the Federal Penitentiary at Leavenworth, and his co-defendants were sentenced to serve ten years and seven and one-half years respectively.

Frequently, scientific analyses in which identifications are made do not always result in presentation of the expert testimony in court, as the defendant, when confronted with conclusive scientific evidence of his guilt will often enter a plea of guilty. William Felty was arrested by State authorities as the result of an investigation conducted by Agents of the Division of Investigation and members of the Frankfort, Indiana Police Department, into an extortion plot against an aged merchant of Frankfort, Indiana. Two demands had been made, one for \$2,000.00 and one for \$4,000.00. The first note had been written with a pencil and the second was typewritten as to the address on the envelope and in pencil writing as to the message. Sample specimens written on a typewriter found in the home of Felty were, upon examination in the Division's Laboratory, found to be identical with the typewriting which appeared on the envelope of the second extortion

Samples of the handprinting of the defendant Felty were reported to be strikingly similar to the printing in the extortion notes and the conclusion was reached that this defendant had unquestionably written these letters. Felty maintained his innocence until the time of trial when he appeared in court and admitted his guilt. He was sentenced to Lerve from three to ten years in the State Reformatory, Pendleton, Indiana.

The cases cited above are indicative of the character of work undertaken in the Laboratory and the results attained. The principal part of the work performed by the experts relates to the examinations of specimens submitted by the Division Field Offices. However, opinions are rendered in State cases when so requested by those authorities. A limited personnel precludes the Division from furnishing experts to testify in State cases but examinations are made and opinions furnished to those officials upon request, in order that they may decide whether local experts should be employed.





INTERESTING IDENTIFICATION

TWO PERSONS SENTENCED TO SERVE TWENTY YEARS IN FLORIDA FOR ARMED ROBBERY IDENTIFIED AS PENNSYLVANIA FUGITIVES

According to information received in the fingerprint section of the Division of Investigation, the Police authorities at Johnstown, Pennsylvania, as well as the State Police officials at Greensburg and Harrisburg, were seeking the apprehension of Joseph James Kapusi and Thomas Gowen for hold-up. Kapusi was also being sought for breaking and entering and larceny, and larceny of an automobile. Notations relative to the fugitive status of each of these persons were placed in the fingerprint files at once. It was observed at that time that both Kapusi and Gowen had served terms in the Cambria County, Pennsylvania Jail during recent years, charged with auto theft and assault and battery.

On April 5, 1934, the Division received fingerprint cards from the Florida State Farm at Raiford, reporting the receipt in that institution on March 30th of persons known as James Gates and Thomas Gowen, to serve twenty years each for the crime of armed robbery. After these fingerprints had been classified and searched it was found that these persons were identical with Kapusi and Gowen, the individuals wanted by the Pennsylvania State authorities, and the said authorities were informed at once of the incarceration of these individuals in the Florida penal institution.

It would appear that the above persons, wanted in Pennsylvania, fled to Florida and became associated in crime there, with the result that they were convicted of the offense of armed robbery in that state and identified as the fugitives wanted in Pennsylvania through the fingerprint files of the Division of Investigation.

INTERESTING IDENTIFICATION

ESCAPED LIFE CONVICT IDENTIFIED BY FINGERPRINTS NEARLY TWENTY-FOUR YEARS LATER

The files of the Identification Unit of the Division of Investigation. U. S. Department of Justice, reflect that Frank Grigware escaped from the United States Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, on April 21, 1910. At that time Grigware was serving a life sentence for robbery, with four accomplices, of a mail train on the Union Pacific Railroad on May 22, 1909, near Omaha, Nebraska. The proceeds of this robbery amounted to \$500 in money, which was taken from mail sacks of the train. After Grigware's escape, an extensive investigation was initiated in an endeavor to secure information relative to his whereabouts but all of these efforts were fruitless. On February 28. 1931, the Division of Investigation issued an Identification Order relative to Grigware. Orders of this character which are fugitive circulars and contain reproductions of the fingerprints, photographs and description of fugitives are prepared by the Division when all apparent tangible leads have been exhausted. Copies of the Order were referred by the Division's field offices to all law enforcement agencies in the United States, to agencies in Canada, and elsewhere.

On March 10, 1934, members of the force of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, arrested one, James Lawrence Fahey, a resident of Jasper, Alberta, Canada, for breaches of the Dominion Park Regulations - Unlawfully Killing Game. Fahey was fined \$200.00 and costs and in default thereof, was sentenced to serve two months' imprisonment. The fine and costs were paid but before discharge Fahey was fingerprinted and it was found by the officials at Edmonton that his finger impressions compared with those appearing in the Identification Order described, issued by the Division of Investigation on February 28, 1931. Upon receipt of information relative to this identification, appropriate steps were initiated to secure Grigware's return to the United States.

The identification of this fugitive after the lapse of nearly 24 years through comparison of his fingerprints is but another illustration of the efficacy of the fingerprint identification system. It has been reported to the Division that Grigware alias Fahey had lived as a respected citizen of Jasper, Alberta, for many years. It appears that he was married at Jasper and that neither his wife nor any members of his family had any knowledge of his past criminal history.




