The Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice, is charged with the duty of investigating violations of the laws of the United States and collecting evidence in cases in which the United States is or may be a party in interest.

The Division does not have investigative jurisdiction over violations of Counterfeiting, Narcotic, Customs, Immigration, or Postal Laws.

However, the Division of Investigation will immediately institute investigations of alleged violations of Federal Laws other than those listed above.

The following list indicates some of the major violations over which the Division has investigative jurisdiction:-

- National Motor Vehicle Theft Act
- National Bankruptcy Act
- White Slave Traffic Act
- Impersonation of Government Officials
- Larceny of Goods in Interstate Commerce
- Cases involving transportation in interstate or foreign commerce of any persons who have been kidnapped
- Theft, Embezzlement or Illegal Possession of Government Property
- Antitrust Laws
- National Bank and Federal Reserve Act Violations, such as embezzlement, abstraction or misapplication of funds
- Crimes on any kind of Government reservation, including Indian Reservations or in any Government building or other Government property
- Neutrality violations, including the shipment of arms to friendly nations
- Frauds against the Government
- Perjury, embezzlement, or bribery in connection with Federal Statutes or officials
- Crimes on the high seas
- The location of persons who are fugitives from justice by reason of violations of the Federal Laws over which the Division has jurisdiction, of escaped Federal prisoners, and parole and probation violators.

It will be appreciated if information in the possession of law-enforcement officials concerning the above listed violations is promptly forwarded to the Special Agent in Charge of the nearest field office of the Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice. If the information indicates that immediate action is necessary, telegrams marked "Government Rate Collect" or telephone calls will be accepted. The address of each of the Field Offices of this Division appears on the inside back cover of this bulletin.

The Attorney General of the United States in his radio address of September 11, 1933 on the subject of "Predatory Crime" said in part:

"The warfare which an armed underworld is waging upon organized society has reached disturbing proportions. The prevalence of predatory crime, including kidnaping and racketeering, demands the utmost diligence upon the part of our law enforcing agencies, supported by an informed and aroused public opinion.

"The Division of Investigation of the Department of Justice has for several months devoted a large part of its time to these two types of crime. Through the public press, and over the radio, you have been given accounts of the progress that has been made.

"It was not until June of 1932, that there existed any Federal statute dealing with kidnaping. This statute, although limited in scope, has been a potent weapon in the hands of public officers.

"It is gratifying to note that every kidnaping case handled by the Division of Investigation since that date, either alone or in co-operation with State authorities, has been solved. Of the 15 kidnaping cases thus reported and investigated, there have resulted 17 convictions, one death sentence, two life sentences and terms of imprisonment aggregating 312 years.

"In addition thereto 30 persons are now in custody in various parts of our country awaiting trial.

"The Division has also been called upon for assistance in cases involving threats to kidnap, usually accompanied by a demand for the payment of money to avert the threatened crime. In 13 such cases the perpetrators have been convicted or are awaiting trial. Sentences aggregating 43 years of imprisonment have already been imposed."

STANDARDIZATION OF WANTED CIRCULARS

The number of fugitives from justice located in other jurisdictions is one of the most convincing arguments for the need of the closest possible cooperation and exchange of information between peace officers throughout the country and the Identification Unit of this Division wherein over 350 fugitives are identified each month.

Realizing the great importance of WANTED NOTICES, through the use of which most of such apprehensions must of necessity be effected, this Division has certain suggestions to make concerning their preparation. These suggestions are offered as the result of experience in this Identification Unit, in the hope that they will prove of assistance.

It is suggested, first, that the size of all wanted notices be standardized at 8" by 8". This will permit ready filing by classification in the fingerprint files of each bureau. There are appended herewith, Figures 1 and 2, sample notices, explaining the exact form which it is believed would prove most effective. Figure 1 illustrates a completed notice, while Figure 2 indicates the nature of the contents thereof.

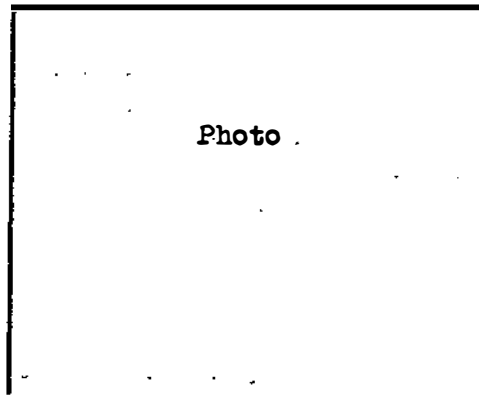

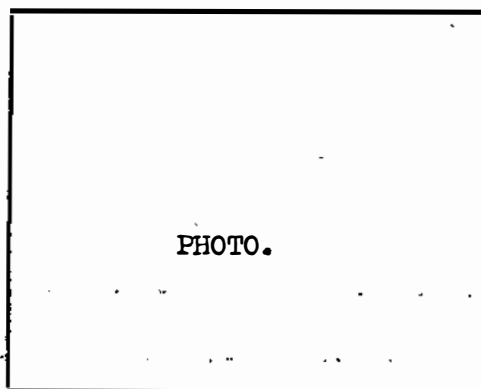

CRIME STATISTICS

It is uniformly agreed that any movement calculated to determine the extent of crime and its fluctuation or intensity must originate with officials most directly connected in point of time with its detection and suppression. Experts unanimously are of the opinion, therefore, that any project the object of which is to determine the quantum and distribution of crime must originate with police records.

It is highly desirable that such information be available for the entire country, but in view of the existing differences in police practices and crime terminology in the forty-eight States of the Union the collection of such information presents difficulties in this country not to be found in other nations where law enforcement is under the control of a centralized agency. For many years the International Association of Chiefs of Police recognized the necessity and the value to police officials of comparable information based on some uniform method of compilation. Accordingly, in 1927 a Committee on Uniform Crime Records was established by the International Association of Chiefs of Police, with the object of providing such a system.

Under authority of legislation approved by the President in 1930 the Division of Investigation assumed the work which had been initiated by the Police Chiefs themselves. Theretofore individual police departments had maintained records in a manner which they felt best served the needs of their immediate locality. Although the records were of value to local police officials, the lack of uniformity prevented extensive comparisons. It became necessary, therefore, to devise a uniform classification of offenses and in addition thereto to instruct and assist police officials in preparing their reports on a standard basis, so that a police official in one section might be enabled to ascertain the extent of crime in his district as compared with other districts and to determine the degree of success met in his section as compared with other sections in combating crime. In undertaking the publication of crime statistics on a national scale the Division of Investigation adopted the uniform classification suggested by the International Association of Chiefs of Police and at the same time recommended to police departments the record system which the police chiefs themselves had devised. Complete instructions for the preparation of statistical reports, contained in the Manual, "Uniform Crime Reporting," are furnished police departments by the Division upon request.

Marked progress has been made in the last three years by the Division of Investigation in developing the project and assisting police departments in preparing the necessary reports. Although the entire plan is worked on a voluntary basis, nevertheless during the first seven months of 1933 there were 1,625 police departments throughout the country from which one or more reports were received. The Division at Washington assumed the duty of compiling the statistics as of September 1, 1930. During the first eight months of 1930 one or more returns were received from 895 police departments, representing a population of approximately 33,000,000 people. ment officers has resulted in increased accuracy in the reports and continued expansion of the reporting area. In December, 1930, there were 1,127 cities, representing a population of approximately 46,000,000, which were registered in the reporting area. During the first seven months of 1933 one or more reports were received from 1,625 contributors, representing a population of 54,716,797 people. There are only three cities having more than 100,000 people from which reports are not received, namely, New York City; Atlanta, Georgia; and Reading, Pennsylvania. Approximately 95 per cent of the cities throughout the country having a population in excess of 50,000 people submit crime statistics reports regularly, and a great majority of smaller cities are in the reporting area.

A bulletin is published quarterly by the Division of Investigation in which the reports are summarized in tables calculated to show the extent of crime during a particular period. The necessary report blanks are furnished law enforcement officials free of charge. In addition, the bulletin includes compilations of data from fingerprint records currently received by the Division. These tabulations relate to the age, sex, race, and previous criminal record of the individuals arrested.

The value of the data collected is, of course, enhanced proportionately to the increase in the size of the reporting area and it is the Division's objective to include every representative police department in the country so that there may be reliable and comprehensive data concerning crime and its extent.

ADOPTION OF STANDARD
CLASSIFICATION OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES

The Division of Investigation adopted in November, 1932, a standard classification of offenses for police, penal and judicial statistics, as recommended by a committee of outstanding experts in criminal statistics in a report submitted to the Director of the Division.

This committee consisted of Professor L. C. Marshall of the Institute of Law of the Johns Hopkins University; Professor Raymond Moley of the School of Law, Columbia University; Mr. Bruce Smith and Miss Audrey Davies of the Institute of Public Administration; Professor W. E. Mikkell of the University of Pennsylvania Law School; Dean Justin Miller of the School of Law, Duke University; Dr. Thorsten Sellin representing the Bureau of the Census; and Mr. James J. Waters of the Division of Investigation. This committee was selected at a general conference of experts in the field of criminal statistics convened at the invitation of the Director of the Division of Investigation and at the offices of the Division at Washington, D. C., in December, 1931, the purpose of that conference being to determine the practicability of adopting a classification of offenses which might be used in the three fields of criminal statistics, namely, police, judicial and penal. While no Federal agency had yet attempted to collect judicial statistics on a national scale, the Division of Investigation has, for some time past, collected, compiled and published offenses known to the police, using a uniform classification of offenses which had been approved by the International Association of Chiefs of Police. The Census Bureau of the United States Department of Commerce has likewise been collecting, compiling and publishing penal statistics, based upon a classification of offenses which, although not essentially different from that used by the Division of Investigation, was not susceptible of ready comparison.

It was the consensus of opinion at the conference of experts that a standard classification of offenses might be devised which would permit of comparison among the three groups of criminal statistics.

The report which was submitted by the special committee appointed by this conference, of which Professor L. C. Marshall was Chairman, sets up a standard classification of offenses which, it is believed, essentially meets this problem. This report, which is the result of nearly a year's study on the part of the special committee, and which was recommended only after consultation with men prominent in penology, the judiciary, and police administration, urged the adoption of a classification of fifteen major groups which are as follows:

1. Criminal homicide
2. Robbery
3. Assault
4. Burglary - breaking or entering
5. Larceny - theft
6. Forgery and counterfeiting
7. Sex offenses
8. Violations of narcotic and drug laws
9. Carrying deadly weapons

11. Violations of liquor laws

Each of the above classifications is susceptible to sub-division to meet the exigencies of local needs.

In addition to recommending a standard classification for national use, the committee recommended, in the interest of accurate statistics, that each state would do well to prepare for the guidance of reporting and compiling officers, a manual which will correlate the offense classification suggested with the other types of classifications requisite to competent criminal statistics. A complete manual of this nature is available for use in police statistics, and is distributed by the Division of Investigation to police officers for their use and guidance. It was also recommended that steps be taken to secure a standardization of local records sufficient to make possible more precise and significant data.

The committee's plan marks a distinct improvement in criminal statistics, because it places the work of the two existing national agencies upon a comparable basis, and makes possible the integration of judicial statistics with police and penal statistics.

The adoption of the standard classification by the Division of Investigation will not necessitate any adjustments or changes in the national system of police reporting which has been under development by that Division for the past several years.

CYRIL WEBBER

FUGITIVE IDENTIFIED THROUGH WANTED
NOTICE CIRCULATED AMONG PEACE OFFICERS.

On March 18, 1929, there was received from Thomas M. Burckes, Chief of Police at Lynn, Massachusetts, a printed wanted circular containing the fingerprints and photograph of Cyril Webber, whose apprehension was sought for participation in a \$3,000 armed robbery at Lynn on March 9, 1929. This notice was posted against the fingerprint record of Webber as it appeared in the files of the Identification Unit of the Division of Investigation.

On December 19, 1932, a second copy of the same wanted circular was forwarded by Chief of Police James H. Broad of Lynn, Massachusetts, indicating the case was still open and Webber's apprehension still desired.

In the February, 1933, issue of the Bulletin "Fugitives Wanted by Police", which is published and distributed among peace officers by the Division of Investigation, a notation was inserted concerning Webber, furnishing his fingerprint classification, and a detailed description including several scars, together with information regarding the crime charged against him.

On July 11, 1933, there was received from the Police Department at Easton, Pennsylvania, the fingerprint card of an individual named Robert Weston, reported to have been arrested at that point on July 9, 1933, charged with investigation. When these fingerprints were classified and searched through the identification files of the Division they were found to be identical with those of the fugitive Cyril Webber and a telegram concerning the identification was immediately dispatched to the authorities at Lynn.

It was later disclosed that Webber, under the name Weston, had been arrested at Easton while intoxicated and brought to the police station for investigation. While in the station he asked permission to get a drink of water at a cooler near the door and immediately endeavored to make his escape by pulling a nearby bench directly across the doorway and leaving the building. He was caught and returned and locked up for the night in the County Jail. The suspicions of the police were aroused by his attempt to escape from what was primarily a minor charge and he was fingerprinted. A copy of these prints was checked with the files maintained in the Identification Bureau of the County Detective's Office and a card was found bearing the same fingerprint classification and making reference to the case of Cyril Webber in the Fugitive Bulletin of the Division of Investigation for February. When Weston was confronted with the detailed physical description of Webber, including the scars, he is reported to have admitted his identity as the Lynn, Massachusetts fugitive, to which city he was returned on July 15, 1933 to answer the robbery charge pending against him there.

ARTHUR HAPPINER

CONFIDENCE MAN
IDENTIFIED THRU FINGERPRINTS

In March of 1933 the Chief of Police of Schenectady, New York communicated with the Division of Investigation of the United States Department of Justice and described one Arthur Happiner wanted for the swindling of a citizen in the amount of \$25,000 cash by means of a confidence game perpetrated between January 3 and January 9, 1933.—With the assistance of the data furnished by the Schenectady officials the Division was enabled to locate a record on this person, also known as Happenie, Harry J.
