The Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice, is charged with the duty of investigating violations of the laws of the United States and collecting evidence in cases in which the United States is or may be a party in interest.

The Division does not have investigative jurisdiction over violations of Counterfeiting, Narcotic, Customs, Immigration, or Postal Laws.

However, the Division of Investigation will immediately institute investigations of alleged violations of Federal Laws other than those listed above.

The following list indicates some of the major violations over which the Division has investigative jurisdiction:-

National Motor Vehicle Theft Act

Interstate transportation of stolen property valued at \$5,000 or more National Bankruptcy Act

Interstate flight to avoid prosecution or testifying in certain cases White Slave Traffic Act

Impersonation of Government Officials

Larceny of Goods in Interstate Commerce

Killing or Assaulting Federal Officer

Cases involving transportation in interstate or foreign commerce of any persons who have been kidnaped

Extortion cases in which interstate commerce or interstate communication is an element

Theft, Embezzlement or Illegal Possession of Government Property Antitrust Laws

Robbery of National Banks and Member Banks of Federal Reserve System National Bank and Federal Reserve Act Violations, such as embezzlement, abstraction or misapplication of funds

Crimes on any kind of Government reservation, including Indian Reservations or in any Government building or other Government property Neutrality violations, including the shipment of arms to friendly nations Frauds against the Government

Crimes in connection with Federal Penal and Correctional Institutions
Perjury, embezzlement, or bribery in connection with Federal Statutes or
officials

Crimes on the high seas

Federal Anti-Racketeering Statute

The location of persons who are fugitives from justice by reason of violations of the Federal Laws over which the Division has jurisdiction, of escaped Federal prisoners, and parole and probation violators.

It will be appreciated if information in the possession of law-enforcement officials concerning the above listed violations is promptly forwarded to the Special Agent in Charge of the nearest field office of the Division of Investigation, U. S. Department of Justice. If the information indicates that immediate action is necessary, telegrams marked "Government Rate Collect" or telephone calls will be accepted. The address of each of the Field Offices of this Division appears on the inside back cover of this bulletin.





INTERESTING IDENTIFICATION

ED. MITCHELL; IKE YOUSTLER; THOMAS FINN

THREE UNKNOWN MEN, KILLED WHILE RESISTING ARREST, IDENTIFIED AS EX-CONVICTS WITH EXTENSIVE RECORDS.

On August 13, 1934, the Identification Unit of the Division of Investigation received from the Police Department at Emporia, Kansas, fingerprint cards of three men who had been slain by Kansas State Police at Emporia on August 9th while resisting arrest. Information accompanied these prints that the identity of these people was unknown.

When these fingerprint cards were searched in the files of the Identification Unit, it was ascertained that each of the individuals whose impressions appeared thereon had an extensive criminal record. One of them was identified as Ed. Mitchell, who had been received in the Kansas State Penitentiary in 1916 to serve a term of from ten to twentyone years for robbery in the first degree and in 1923 had been received in the Oklahoma State Penitentiary to serve a term of twenty-five years for conjoint robbery. Another was identified as Ike Youstler, whose criminal record, extending from 1915 to 1931, included incarcerations in the State Penitentiaries of Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma and Arkansas, for the offenses of burglary, jail breaking and grand larceny. The third was identified as Thomas Finn who had been received in the State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Missouri in 1905, to serve a term of nine years for first degree robbery, and in 1919 had been received in the same institution to serve a term of five years for burglary in the second degree and larceny. On the same day the fingerprints of these people were received in the Division, advice of the above identifications was transmitted by wire to the Police Department at Emporia, Kansas.

The above case is illustrative of the efficacy of fingerprint service in identifying deceased persons, as well as making usual identifications whereby prior criminal records of persons under arrest are determined.

INTERESTING IDENTIFICATION

RICHARD DEWEY

ESCAPED GEORGIA CONVICT IDENTIFIED THROUGH FUGITIVE BULLETIN.

A fingerprint card was received in the Division of Investigation on May 7, 1932 from the Police Department of Albany, Georgia, indicating that one Richard Dewey was arrested and charged with bank robbery on May 4, 1932. Information subsequently received reflected that he had been sentenced to serve from two to four years on this charge. The Police Department at Albany, advised the Division in a communication received on January 30, 1934, that Dewey had escaped from the State Road Camp in Baker County, Georgia, where he had been serving this sentence. A wanted notice was immediately placed on the fingerprint card maintained in the Division's fingerprint files and in the April, 1934, issue of the bulletin "Fugitives Wanted by Police".

In July, 1934, advice was received from the Police Department at Macon, Georgia that a subject was arrested on July 15, 1934, on a charge of investigation. The authorities at Macon further advised that after arrest the subject's fingerprints were taken and checked against the file maintained by that department. Immediate identification was established with the finger impression of Richard Dewey which had been cut out of the April issue of the bulletin "Fugitives Wanted by Police".

The above case is an illustration of the value of the bulletin in establishing the identity of fugitives immediately upon their arrest.

OFFENSES KNOWN TO THE POLICE June and July 1934

The compilation presented below is based upon the number of offenses reported for June and July, 1934 by 79 police departments in cities having a population in excess of 100,000. The daily averages of offenses known are also presented. In this connection it should be observed that the figures representing the number of offenses reported are not susceptible to direct comparison due to the difference in the number of days, June having only 30 days and July having 31. The daily average therefore should be employed for comparative purposes.

A comparison of the daily averages for the two months indicated shows the following increases in July as compared with June:

Murder and non-negligent manslaughter	13.9%
Aggravated assault	11.5%
Burglary-breaking or entering	4.7%
Robbery	4.6%

However, decreases are shown for the following offenses:

Manslaughter by negligence	20.5%
Rape	7.0%
Auto theft	5.3%
Larceny-theft	2.1%

A PAGE ON THE PAST OF FINGERPRINTS.

Dr. Valentin Sava.

Fingerprinting, that science which has realized such a marked place in the service of society in the combatting of the elements of evil, has attained a degree of prestige which is hard to contest.

The identification of an individual through the papillary ridges of his fingers marks a great step in the evolution of the problem of identification, for it is the final step which has put at man's disposal a sign that is placed in the human body by nature herself and differs in a most precise manner in every individual and is a quality of such a character that it never changes in the entire course of life no matter what may be the change in growth or looks.

So extraordinary is the precision of this method of identification that fingerprinting has been adopted all over the world not only with respect to criminal matters but also in the affairs of civil life to eliminate the possibility of fraud.

This method of identification has been known since the heroic era. The discoveries of Vucetich brought it out clearly and showed the benefits of its traces over the anthropometric system with incredible clarity. It was so straight and rational that belief in it was assured. Its probate infallibility was demonstrated before magistrates so well that they approved it freely and it gained public faith as well. Thus the axiom developed that a proved fingerprint is sufficient in justice to place a person at a scene. Jurisprudence in this sense has accepted and stabilized it in England, France, Germany, the Scandinavian countries, all the States in America, etc. The first death penalty on this evidence was pronounced in criminal court in Chicago. In France in the same manner there was captured an assassin, Didier by name, who was executed on the strength of a fingerprint impression found at the scene of the crime, which was the only good proof, in spite of the denials of the culprit.

The greatest obstacle which impeded the progress of the fingerprint science and over which it finally triumphed, was anthropometry. This method of identification, evolved by Bertillon, a modest official in the Identification Bureau at Paris in 1879, made its appearance a short time before fingerprints and enjoyed extraordinary fame. It consisted in the careful measurements and diameters of certain parts of the body classified in order. This method was of very appreciable value to justice.

We shall present the greatest defects which are cited for it.

The Vucetich - Bertillon dispute was passionate. At first the dispute consisted of experimental arguments but finally when it was brought before a congress for decision the concensus of opinion was in favor of fingerprints and it began to be adopted in different identification services to supplant Bertillon.

With respect to this it is interesting to know that a powerful argument against Bertillon was furnished to Vucetich by a Roumanian professor, Dr. Nicolae Minovici.

He had been from the start a passionate Bertillonist and had adopted that system of identification which had enjoyed a rapid spread in Europe and Northern Africa and proved its value since it had a firm anthropometric foundation. However over a period of time there grew up certain differences in values and measurements which made the system inconvenient. When fingerprints appeared he became a devoted enthusiast of the system as is evidenced in the following correspondence.

The first letter of Prof. Minovici, found in the dusty archives of the Judicial Identification Service, translated into the Spanish tongue, appeared in the April 15, 1906 number of the 'Police Review' of Montevideo, Uruguay, in which review also appeared the autographed reply of Vucetich. I believe that the publishing of these two letters will present a page of greatest interest in the history of the development of fingerprints besides paying tribute to the scientific prestige of Prof. Minovici, who in these matters was the pioneer explorer in Roumania and perhaps in Europe.

bers of the same family. This idea first inspired me to hope that it would be a method of tracing private inheritances on the supposition that some traces of this sort would be inherited. Unfortunately I did not obtain any satisfactory results and was able to publish nothing on this matter.

This question however I abandoned as not being tolerable and not profound enough.

The second matter which has occupied me in this regard for twelve years has been the immutability of the impressions in a certain individual. The results in this however have been very satisfactory. For example: A comparison was made of the impressions of 40 convicted criminals whose fingerprints were taken at the beginning of their sentence and the most recent prints of the same men and it was verified that the prints were exactly the same after a lapse of 12 years.

The result of this from the point of view of discovering the criminal may be illustrated by two cases.

- 1/ About ten years ago there was a theft committed in the office of a large printing establishment. The fingerprint impressions of someone were noted on the paper of a ledger book, which when they were compared turned out to be those of the perpetrator of the crime who was one of the apprentices of the printer.
- 2/ The second was a recent case. This case was one of an individual who stole the rubber from some carriage wheels. Thanks to the fingerprint impressions left on the wheel it was possible to discover the author of the crime, who was a neighbor.

Continuing with this idea it occurred to me to use it with regard to the many illiterates and to this purpose I addressed this plan to the Ministers of Justice and Interior and to the Prefect of Police of Bucharest, that in place of signatures of these the prints of the right hand be substituted. This reform was adopted immediately after I proposed it.

With regard to the introduction of the fingerprint impressions in place of signatures I am convinced that in many cases it is preferable to use the impressions, for unlike the signatures they cannot be imitated or changed. Expert penmen, in many cases can imitate signatures but fingerprint impressions even if they are carefully copied or re-impressed are not the original but negative impressions. Thus while copies are possible, exact impressions cannot be produced.

As I have said before I have occupied myself a great deal with fingerprints and it is a system which I admire very much. An actual study of the functioning of the service of identification serves to show the varied work of its direction. There is the work of handling records, photos, fingerprints etc., which is often more complicated than need be and in many instances could be very much simplified.

And it is rather too bad that the theoretical exposition of the Bertillon system, which affirms that it is based on mathematical precision should be marred by such different results.

In practice however the results are varied in spite of the fact





that measurements are made with care by trained and conscientious employees.

In order to gain a good idea of all the systems I visited all the services of the major European capitols: London, Berlin, Paris, Vienna, Hamburg, Stockholm, Rome, Venice, Nice, Belgrade, Madrid, Lisbon, Lausanne, Cairo, The Hague, Amsterdam, Brussels, etc. and in all of them particularly examined the anthropometric phase of the work. Having done this and compared data I am convinced of the imperfections of the systems for in all of them there existed an appreciable difference in figures. It is certain that it is not possible to abolish suddenly the anthropometric bureaus and adopt the fingerprint system exclusively for it would be impossible to transform the archives where there are classified so many records by measurements.

It is my opinion that the best course in the circumstances is to form a bureau exclusively for fingerprints. Then there will be no need for transfer in any sense. The system could be modeled after the arrangement I have here in Bucharest, with cross references between measurement files and the fingerprint archive.

Bertillon himself when I had the occasion of asking him about it admitted the importance of the fingerprint impression and stated that from its inception he had used it in his service. In the course of the conversation with him with respect to the future of the fingerprint system I said that I believed that this system would be much more successful than the system of Bertillon himself, to which he exclaimed, "That is true. But is it only Bertillon who can invent a system?"

The ten finger system has come to be firmly established in Europe and even from its beginning it has proved its immense value and its growth has been much more marked than anthropometry. All in all it has become strong and sound. In concluding this letter I might remark that on its inception in most places in Europe it was utilized more or less for auxiliary purposes but so well was it mentioned that it has come to be placed firmly in the foreground.

I have enclosed digests of longer communications which I made formerly to the Ministry of the Interior and Public Safety when I was officially introducing fingerprints.

In this respect kindly accept my permission to reproduce any passages which may be of interest to you. Let me know also of any modifications introduced in your system. I am working at the present time on some matter for the 'Legal Medicine' which I will furnish you when it has been completed. I would appreciate your sending me your last work, 'Conferences of the Congress of Rio de Janiero'.

I hope you will have the best of success with your work and your writing and I beg to end this missive with the expression of my most interested and affectionate regard.

My very distinguished friend:

I wish to acknowledge your very welcome letter of February 28 and beg you to excuse me for waiting so long to answer it and respond to your requests for copies of my work which you are kind enough to hold in such high regard.

I shall write you first of Montevideo where I have been to attend the meeting of the fingerprint association.

The opening speech was made by my friend Dr. Alexander Sarachaga, Medico-Legalist and Director of the fingerprint Bureau, who has been a very fine confrere of mine indeed in this locality. This good friend, after I had given my consent, is going to have your letter translated into Spanish and published in the police review.

On the matter of reproducing this work he argued with me thus. The opinion expressed by Dr. Minovici cannot help but compel those who still do
not know of the most certain results which have been found out and it will
be a source of convincing the public that here from another quarter is a categorical affirmation of the system and this praise will be a source of energy
to us. This reply is much better than any that could be made by me. When this
article appears in the afore mentioned review the credit that will be yours will
excuse this indiscretion of ours.

With regard to the private studies which you have made on the science of fingerprints from the point of view of heredity, my friend Dr. Rodolfo Sennet, Professor of Anthropology at the University of La Plata has busied himself along these same lines.

It has been well documented from investigations on both sides in order to verify the direct influence of heredity on the descendents produced that there is nothing in the fingerprint idea and the prints of five generations have been put in evidence and there is no influence and no rule can be applied for alternate generations.

Sennet is in possession of the impressions of every member of two families. In the first family it was begun with the great grandfather and followed the paternal line down to the great grandchildren, (the family of Sennet himself) and the second from the great grandfather but followed the maternal line in the same manner.

These individuals gave a very clear and precise idea of the total lack of similarity of the finger impressions, those taken in the first series from the great grandfather through the paternal line to the great grandchildren and the other through the maternal line as above.

Upon a comparison made in each case there was found to be a total lack of similarity between the impressions of father and son and also each finger taken apart presented such a great difference that it attracted immediate attention.

The dissimilarity remarked lay in this that while both great grandfathers had whorls in the fingers this form did not hold in the series and the great grandson R. M. S. had two arches which could not be found in any of the ancestors. In the series of the maternal side the same result was observed. For example arches that were found in the thumbs of two nephews could not be located in the entire series. In a comparison of the formulae of the entire series based on the ten fingers there was not a single case in which two were found to be identical. Studied from the viewpoint of alternate heredity the formulae presented did not give any indications which would have the least bearing or influence on heredity in these cases.

In the two series there was noticed a very marked lack of similarity. In the entire five generations of the two families, there was not a single case of identity of the two formulae precluding anything but doubt with regard to the final influence of heredity.

In this series there were two twins whose formulae differed as follows:

From a study of all these points it was apparent that no rules of heredity could be applied to fingerprint impressions. This detracted nothing from my system but rather added to its strength.

There are offered for consideration the results arrived at by Sennet.

- 1/ The disposition of the papillary ridges cannot be transmitted through heredity in accordance with any of the known laws of heredity, either conservative or progressive.
- 2/ There was no case observed where the homotic heredity law could be applied or any other heredity law.
- 3/ Over five generations there was no evidence of the law of alternate heredity.
- 4/ With regard to the disposition of the papillary ridges there was no biological law or any data which could tend to show any here-ditary effects even in the first stages of ontogenital evolution, (primary state of intrauterine life).

It is believed that the relation of these papillary ridges is governed by some unknown cause, that is one that has not yet been found.

Nature creates immutable and universal laws. In each one of the species individual characteristics are transmitted which differentiate one from the other, even in the cases of twins.

The disposition of the papillary ridges does not depend on heredity and there was no indication given in the whole series which would prove the influence the matter of heredity had and we are forced to conclude that it is an example in the work of nature by which an individual is differentiated under the general law, the cause of which must be attributed to some force beyond our experience and knowledge.

Almost twenty-five years have passed since this was written. Since that time the science of fingerprints has grown from the precarious position it held fighting for its very existence to a tried and proven system.

At first it was thought remarkable that 13 years had made no difference in the fingerprint impressions but now we have cases of 25 - 30 years which demonstrate the certain immutability of the fingerprint impression.

The question of heredity has been more recently studied in the German school but with negative results. It is regretable that no basis could be found in heredity along this line for it would have been of inestimable value along these lines. But the results have had a very strengthening effect on the science of fingerprints. Personally I have been interested enough to study in this matter three sets of twin foetii and I am pleased to state that there were no two formulae alike nor were any individual fingers in any way duplicated.

From this correspondence there were abundant similar results extending into other spheres of activity than ours and society has more recently imitated adopted and borrowed and benefited from our experience and the original Scientific Police of Dr. Minovici has held together his ideas and built them up for its greater scientific authority.


